During the 2009-2010 school-year students may receive a scholarship of \$270 per month to cover the cost of tuition. The yearly tuition is \$3000 of which a minimum of 10% or \$300 must be paid. The ability to pay tuition will not be a determining factor in a child's acceptance to attend school. In addition to tuition, families are required to volunteer a minimum of 8 hours a month at the school and attend monthly parent/family meetings. If the full tuition cannot be paid, we ask that you make a donation that fits you budget or volunteer extra hours at the school. If you have any questions or this policy isn't clear don't hesitate to contact the school. No child will be turned down due to financial difficulties.
