

learn yoʔ... – To learn; to gain/have knowledge. See: *know*.

yoʔnunm – To learn.

yoʔnuis – S/he/it learned it. yoʔnun, yoʔnuntxʷ

es yoʔnunms – S/he/it is learning it. ies yoʔnunm, as yoʔnunm

qs yoʔnunms – S/he/it is going to learn it. iqs yoʔnunm, aqs yoʔnunm

yoʔoʔnuis – They learned it. qe yoʔnuntm, yoʔnuntp

es yoʔoʔnunms – They are learning it. qe es yoʔnunm, es yoʔnunmp

qs yoʔoʔnunms – They are going to learn it. qeqs yoʔnunm, qs yoʔnunmp

ñem yoʔnuis – S/he/it will learn it. ñem yoʔnun, ñem yoʔnuntxʷ

ñem yoʔoʔnuis – They will learn it. ñem qe yoʔnuntm, ñem yoʔnuntp

yoʔnunt – Learn it. (*comm.*)

kʷemt stem ʰu qeqs yoʔnunm yetʰa – Then what are we going to learn today? qe es

yoʔnunm qe nqʷlqʷeltn – We are learning our language. eni ʰiçt ʰu seliš nqʷlqʷeltn qs

yoʔnunm – Gee, Salish is hard to learn (*woman speaking*).

mipnunm – To figure out something; find out something; to complete an understanding; to learn.

mipnuis – S/he/it found it out. mipnun, mipnuntxʷ

es mipnunms – S/he/it is finding it out. ies mipnunm, as mipnunm

qs mipnunms – S/he/it is going to find it out. iqs mipnunm, aqs mipnunm

mipnuʔuis – They found it out. qe mipnuntm, mipnuntp

es mipnuʔunms – They are finding it out. qe es mipnunm, es mipnunmp

qs mipnuʔunms – They are going to find it out. qeqs mipnunm, qs mipnunmp

mipnunt – Find out. (*comm.*)

ñem mipnuis – S/he/it will find it out. ñem mipnun, ñem mipnuntxʷ

ñem mipnuʔuis – They will find it out. ñem qe mipnuntm, ñem mipnuntp

ñem aqes mipnunm – You will be finding it out. ñem iqes mipnunm, ñem iqes mipnunm

ñexʷ ta es yoʔstép ʰu sçtip – Also you guys Don't know how to hunt.

ha es yoʔstéxʷ ʰu stqʷléʔ – Do you know sign language?

least sšým ʰuweʔ – Least.

leather piçlxʷ – Leather. Rt.: piç – glossy; suffix: ...lxʷ – skin, hide.

çpiççeʔ – Suitcase; leather suitcase. Rt.: piç – glossy; suffix: ...ičéʔ – to be covered in.

çʷulixʷélxʷ – Hide of deer; buckskin.

leave qʷmepm – To leave of more than one person.

qʷméʔepm – They left. qe qʷmepm, p qʷmepm

ʰékʷ – Leave.

ʰékʷš – Leave, get out of here, get out of the way. (*comm.*)

ʰékʷwi – All of get out of here. (*comm.*)

ʰil – To be still. See: *still*.

ʰilskʷ – Leave it be still; leave it alone. (*comm.*)

ʰilskʷwi – All of you leave it be still; leave it alone. (*comm.*)

ʰel – Strs. rt., abandon, throw away, leave. See: *abandon*.

eñés – To be on the way to somewhere. See: *go*.

hoysk^w – Quit, leave him/her/it alone. (*comm.*) See: [stop](#).

k^wʔnq^wmist, k^wʔnq^wmi – To run away; to sneak away; to leave; escape. See: [escape](#).

leaves picčʔ – Leaf. pcpicčʔ (*pl.*)

ledge ʔʔamqne - Ledge.

leech ʔamyó – Cowry, snail, leech.

left handed sčciq^wečst, sčci – Left hand.

es čciq^wečst – S/he is left-handed. čnes čciq^wečst, k^wes čciq^wečst

left over smʔáw – Leftover things.

qe ep smʔáw – We have left overs.

sčmawá – Leftover food.

squmcn – Leftover food you take with you for later.

left side sčciq^wečst, sčci – Left hand.

es čci – S/he is left-handed. čnes čci, k^wes čci

sčciq^wisšn – Left foot.

leg sččmáqstšn – Leg. sčmčmáqstšn (*pl.*)

...áqstšn – Suffix indicating leg.

čʔx^wix^w cáqstšn – Short legged person.

čʔqeyq^w áqstšn – Skinny legs.

čususnáqstšn – Long legged person.

talaqstšn – To move/shake/bounce leg; releasing/relaxing from the leg and foot. See: [untie](#).

es talaqstšni – S/he is bouncing his/her leg. čnes talaqstšni, k^wes talaqstšni

pn̄pn̄ši – To have legs and feet in a laying position; almost in a lazy state. See: [lay](#).

k^w qes pn̄pn̄ši – Lay down with your legs out. (*comm.*)

ta k^w qes pn̄pn̄ši – Don't lay down with your legs out. (*comm.*)

n̄x^wl̄x^wallpusšni – Shaky, tired legs. See: [shake](#).

n̄x^wl̄x^wallpusšn – S/he/it had shaky legs. čn n̄x^wl̄x^wallpusšn, k^w n̄x^wl̄x^wallpusšn

leggings s̄xéʔišn – Legging. s̄x̄ʔeʔišn (*pl.*)

lemon čk^wlk^waliʔ – Lemon.

lend k^wuʔn – Borrow, lend.

čnes k^wuʔni – I'm borrowing.

lent putʔéy – Fasting.

leopard frog ʔmʔamá, ʔmʔamáyeʔ – Frog, spotted frog.

lesbian sx^wntaʔʔa – Lesbian, gay woman.

less ʔuwet, ʔu – Few, less.

sšýmʔu – Least.

let lciʔstm.

let go p̄ʔéčstm – To release something from the hand. See: [release](#).

letter **qimin** – Paper/book.

scqi – Written word/letter; something that's written.

scqiqi – Words/letters.

stem ye scqi – What letter is this.

Í čen u n?ečxilcn ye scqi – How does this letter sound

sc?aw?aw – Spoken words; something that's said.

lettuce **picčt.** – Leaf, cabbage, lettuce.

Lewis' woodpecker **ciwcu** – Lewis' woodpecker.
